**Doddington Lane, Newnham**  
**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER JANUARY 2022**

To allow renewal works to be carried out on apparatus, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Doddington Lane, Newnham.

A closure is planned from 31st January 2022, with estimated completion by 4th February 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB00627844360-01 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Doddington Lane will be closed 230 metres east of Park Cottage, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while renewal works on apparatus are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via The Street, Chequers Hill, Doddington Lane, Christophers Row, Lynsted Lane, A2 London Road, Faversham Road and vice versa.
